PRIZES & TOURNAMENT RULES

JULY 8TH, CAPTAINS MEETING

JULY 9TH, TURNAMENT

1. **\$2,000** AND TROPHY FOR THE BOAT WITH THE SINGLE LARGEST DOLPHIN BY WEIGHT.
2. **\$1,000** AND TROPHY FOR THE BOAT WITH THE SECOND LARGEST DOLPHIN BY WEIGHT
3. **\$500** AND TROPHY FOR THE BOAT WITH THE THIRD LARGEST DOLPHIN BY WEIGHT
4. **\$300** FOR THE BOAT WITH THE FOURTH LARGEST DOLPHIN BY WEIGHT.
5. **\$150** FOR THE BOAT WITH THE FIFTH LARGEST DOLPHIN BY WEIGHT.
6. **\$500** FOR THE LARGEST KINGFISH BY WEIGHT.
7. **\$500** FOR THE LARGEST WAHOO BY WEIGHT.
8. **\$500** FOR THE LARGEST TUNA BY WEIGHT
QUALIFYING SPECIES INCLUDE, BLACKFIN, YELLOWFIN AND BLUEFIN. REQUIRES HIGHLY MIGRATORY SPECIES PERMIT.
9. TROPHY AWARDED TO THE WOMAN ANGLER WITH THE LARGEST QUALIFYING SPECIES BY WEIGHT.
10. TROPHY AWARDED TO THE JUNIOR ANGLER WITH THE LARGEST QUALIFYING SPECIES BY WEIGHT.
11. JUNIOR ANGLERS MUST NOT HAVE REACHED THEIR 15TH BIRTHDAY BY THE DAY OF THE TOURNAMENT.
12. ONLY ONE TOURNAMENT CASH PRIZE IN THE DOLPHIN CATEGORY PER REGISTERED BOAT.
13. THE TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE WILL AWARD ALL PRIZES. COMMITTEES DECISIONS ARE FINAL.
14. ALL ANGLERS MUST HAVE A VALID STATE OF FLORIDA FISHING LICENSE.
15. NO BOAT LENGTH LIMITATIONS AND ALL BAITS ARE ALLOWED.
16. ALL TAXES FOR CASH PRIZES ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE WINNER.
17. **CAPTAIN'S MEETING.** ONE ANGLER FROM EACH BOAT MUST ATTEND THE CAPTAIN'S MEETING AT IGFA FISHING HALL OF FAME & MUSEUM ON FRIDAY July 8, 2005. FROM 5:00 P.M. TO 8:00 PM. TO REGISTER ALL ANGLERS.
18. **THE TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE THE REGISTRATION OF ANY ANGLER.**
19. ALL PERSONS IN A BOAT ARE CONSIDERED ANGLERS. REGISTRATION FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.
20. **CHECK-OUT.** THE COMMITTEE BOAT WILL BE IN PORT EVERGLADES NEAR THE COAST GUARD STATION SATURDAY JULY 9, 2005 AT 6:00 A.M. AND REMAIN UNTIL 7:15 A.M. THE COMMITTEE BOAT WILL MONITOR RADIO CHANNEL #73
21. **ANY BOATS NOT VISUALLY CHECKED OUT BY THE COMMITTEE BOAT WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FROM THE TOURNAMENT.**
22. LATE CHECKOUTS MUST CONTACT THE COMMITTEE BOAT BY RADIO CHANNEL #74, PRIOR TO 7:15 A.M. TO MAKE ARRANGEMENTS FOR VISUAL CHECKOUT OR BE DISQUALIFIED FROM THE TOURNAMENT.
23. AFTER CHECK-OUT WITH COMMITTEE BOAT YOU MAY SAFELY PROCEED TO YOUR FISHING AREA. A GENTLEMEN'S START WITH LINES IN THE WATER WILL BEGIN AT 7:00 A.M.
24. **NO-WAKE ZONES AND UNSAFE BOATING WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED DURING WEIGH-IN BY B.S.O.**
25. WEIGH-IN STARTS AT 1:00 P.M. AND ENDS AT 3:00 P.M. AT I.T. PARKER COMMUNITY CENTER. ALL ANGLERS MUST BE IN LINE WITH FISH IN HAND AT WEIGH-IN STATION PRIOR TO 3:00 P.M. THE WEIGHMASTER WILL IDENTIFY THE LAST ELIGIBLE ANGLER IN LINE, TO BE WEIGHED IN.
26. ALL FISH MUST BE IN EDIBLE CONDITION AND CAUGHT WITHIN TOURNAMENT HOURS. ALL WEIGHED FISH MAY BE SUBJECT TO INSPECTION BY THE TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE.
27. ALL FISH MUST BE OF LEGAL SIZE AND LIMITS.
28. ONLY BOATS ON THE WATER CAN BRING FISH TO THE WEIGH-IN AREA. NO BOATS ARE ALLOWED TO BRING FISH TO THE WEIGH-IN AREA ON TRAILERS.
29. IN THE EVENT OF A TIE, THE PRIZE MONEY AND/OR TROPHY WILL GO TO THE ANGLER THAT WEIGHED THEIR FISH EARLIEST.
30. **AWARDS CEREMONY WILL FOLLOW WEIGH-IN.**
